

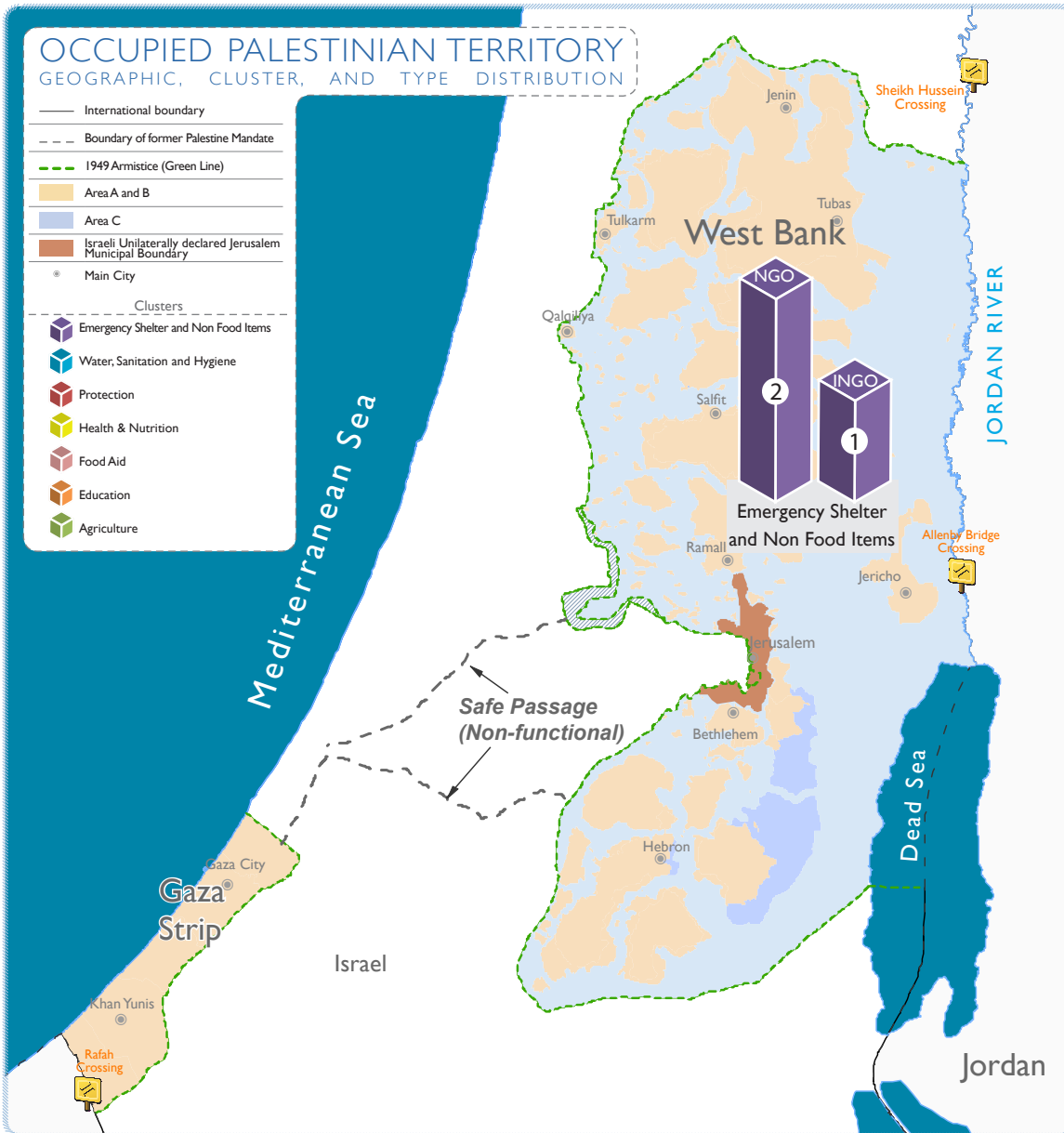

Proposals Received & Funds Disbursed:

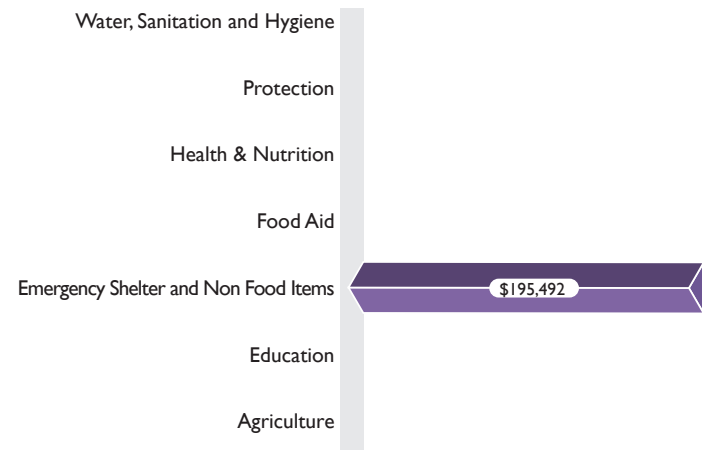
Since January 1st 2012, the HRF in oPt has received 5 project proposals for a total amount of US\$ 1,180,006. These include 2 proposals for projects in the Gaza strip and 3 projects in the West Bank. Three projects were approved to address needs for Emergency Shelter and Non-Food Items. A total of US\$ 195,492 have been already disbursed for one project.
