# Village Assessment Methodology

December 2008

## COOPI VILLAGE SURVEY DATABASE

COOPI staff together with the international expatriates has been developing since 2002 a village assessment in order to have a clear idea of the socio-economic conditions in each governorate and in each village of the Northern West Bank. Data collection has been done through a questionnaire<sup>1</sup> filled in by each municipality/local council of cities and villages: the assessment has been done in almost all the villages and cities of the district of North West Bank.

The main idea of the Data Base is to have a constant and holistic monitoring of the reality in the Northern West Bank and Gaza Strip at a community level. The main subjects covered by the questionnaire are:

- Village Economic Data
- School Survey
- Health Survey
- Livestock survey
- Agriculture survey
- Condition of Infrastructure
- Separation Wall Constraints
- Past NGO Activities

The population covered belongs to 234 cities and villages and it represents 60% of the whole country: about 2,2 million of inhabitants within the governorates of Ramallah, Salfit, Qalqiya, Nablus, Jenin, Tulkarem, Tubas and the Gaza Strip. In each governorate the percentage of population reached by the assessment is almost 90% with the only exception of Ramallah (5%) and Nablus (60%). Supported by this study the COOPI international staff selects the villages to target in the Job Creation Programmes, based on the basic needs assessment, the major problems declared by each community and the overall situation in the region. COOPI is dealing with construction activities: therefore the form proposes also accurate questions on local infrastructures. Schools, roads, health centres and hospitals represent the relevant information collected through the questionnaire. COOPI focuses its attention on the level of services offered by the local municipalities and the limits of the public services, as a consequence of the restrictions imposed by Israel. The main subjects covered by the questionnaire are:

The information collected covers the general topics of each village, as the number of inhabitants: the most important data for COOPI activities are represented by the level of income before and after the Intifada, the actual rate of unemployment and the number of inhabitants who have lost their opportunity to work in Israel or in the settlements due to the reinforcement of the Occupation regime in 2001. Other data provide a general background of the economic status of each village pointing out the major priorities for each community.

The main features of this village survey is that it is not a questionnaire proposed directly to the single inhabitants of the village, but to their representatives<sup>2</sup>. However they know the overall

socio-economic situation of the area. The municipalities are requested to fill in the form according to their information. Usually data collection directly from persons living in the district cannot be accurate as a statistical survey, but at the same time could grasp the living conditions as perceived by the local communities. The risk is the over-estimation of the problem: people filling the forms are aware that the survey is made by an International NGO for implementing further projects in the district. Their own private interest could push them to depict a worse situation than the reality in order to get international aid. Nevertheless, the data collected show conformity with the National Survey edited by the Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics (PCBS) especially regarding the rate of unemployment and trend of the loss of income. This confirms the *accuracy* and the *consistency* of the COOPI survey.

On the basis of the villages Data Base, COOPI International Staff has classified the priorities in terms of economic drop of income and unemployment rate in North West Bank. Its method help identify macro areas where economic conditions have been worsening more. The process entails to select first the governorates suffering more the lack of job opportunities, then the areas and finally the villages.

The comparison of different districts and, within the governorates, of villages and cities is based on a special rank: the **Needs Approach Rank**<sup>3</sup>. Through the analysis of the DB, a socio-economic index, capable to collect the information and to classify the villages on the basis of their needs is created. The variables have to catch the villages more distressed by the unemployment rate and the drop of income after the second Intifada. The index is adjusted with information on the actual income and on the population size.

The index is composed of three variables: unemployment rate, drop of income and a mixed indicator comprising the population size and the actual income. All the variables are ranked in relation to a selected variable, giving the value one to the unit with the high value and so on to the unit with the lowest level of the variable considered. The same is done for all the variables. The result is a needs index capable to measure the major problem faced by the local communities:

**Needs Rank = 4/10 Unempl. Rank + 4/10 Drop Income Rank + 2/10 (½ Popul. size+½ Income Lev.)**

The last two variables are weighed less because the unemployment rate and the fall of income are considered as more important variables. The population size and the actual income level are introduced in order to give priority to poor units and to populated areas. Finally ordering the index from the lowest to the highest value, it provided a rank of villages based on their needs.
























The Needs Rank shows the global status of West Bank. COOPI objective is to spread the action in the whole region with the aim to avoid the replication of its Cash for Work programmes in the same village, so that for the final choice of the villages another important consideration is done on the basis of the past COOPI areas of intervention. Other determinants for the selection of the villages are related to logistic issues and the dimension of the action. COOPI prefers to work in villages, close one to each other, looking for cost reduction of the logistic expenditures and maximisation of the quota of funds spent on the final beneficiaries. The idea is to select a small area in which more villages are considered as a priority. The amount of people living in an area determines another condition for the final choice of the villages: it is preferable to have a large

group of potential beneficiaries. In this case the real risk is to involve people coming from the outskirts of the village, who have to support transportation costs, not covered by the project. The second argument in favour of the selection of populated areas is related to the dimension of the action. In a big spot, the intervention of rehabilitation could be really effective, reaching the real community needs. Actually fixed costs are relative lower when a big number of workers are involved (more than 100) and when the action last for long time, more than a shift of 20 days. The ratio of 70-30 between workers and material automatically penalised the small communities in terms of infrastructures realisations. COOPI noticed that local communities contributions is particularly efficient in the small ones to maximise the result 2. (rehabilitation of public infrastructures).

















This approach does not mean that the small villages are always cut-off from COOPI projects: they can be included in the area strategy, especially in programmes where COOPI recognizes that a micro region is suffering a lack of job opportunities.



