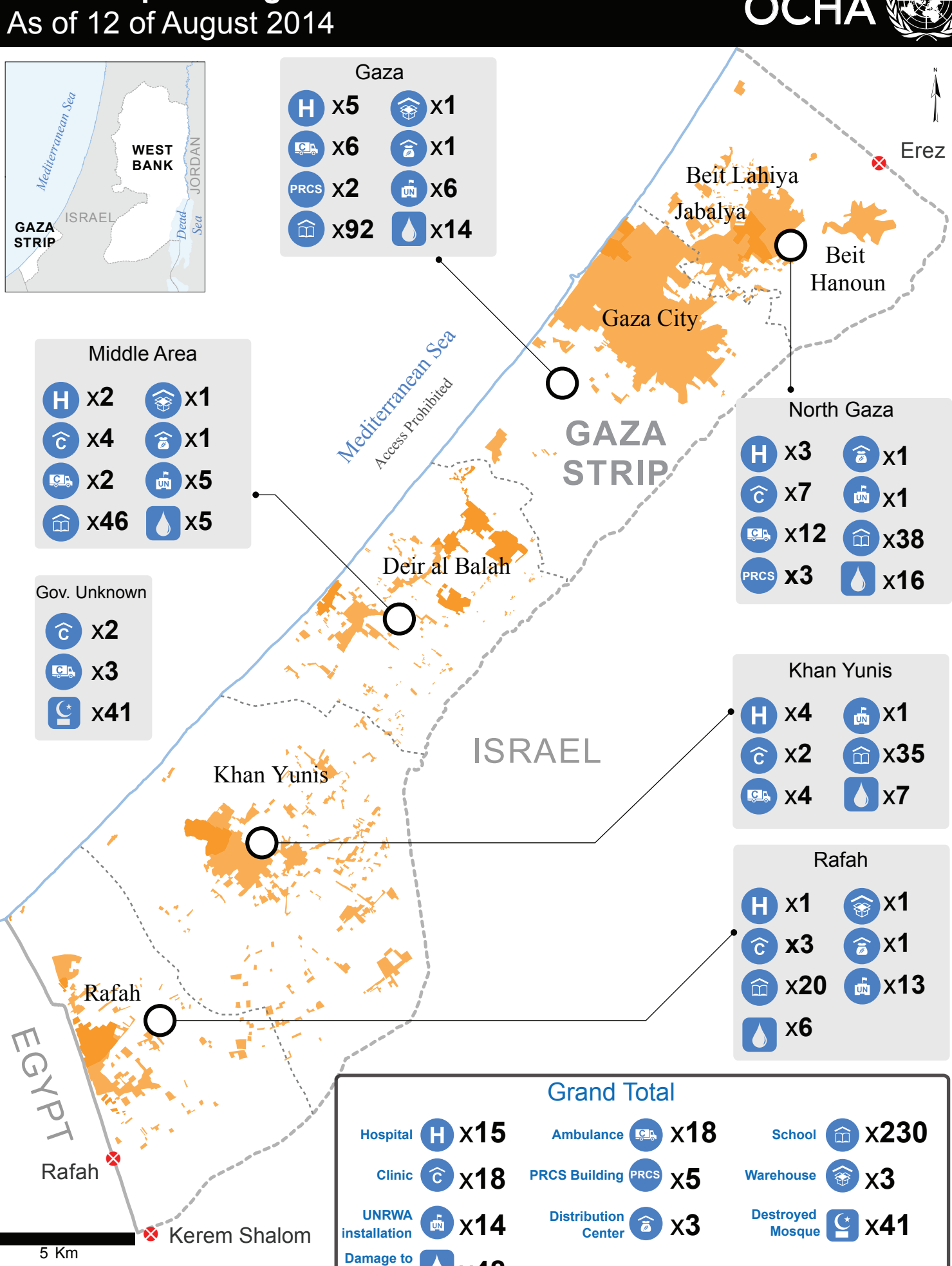

Residential Structures

It is estimated that 16,735 families, consisting of approximately 100,410 individuals, have no home to return to as they were totally destroyed or heavily damaged. These families are in need of emergency NFI kits and will require longer-term support until repairs/reconstruction can take place.

5,635 families (33,800 individuals), whose homes were damaged but are still inhabitable, and another 33,485 families (an estimated 200,900 individuals), whose homes sustained minor damage, need basic NFI assistance such as nylon and plastic sheets.
