
The snapshot provides a comprehensive overview of the ongoing humanitarian crisis in Gaza as of 21 January 2024, including casualties, particularly among women and children.

91 **MOVEMENT AND ACCESS**

 Civilian access to areas to the north of Wadi Gaza is only possible to humanitarian teams; however, in the first two weeks of 2024 the Israeli military denied the access of most aid missions to those areas.

- The Rafah crossing with Egypt and the Kerem Shalom crossing with Israel are open for the entry of approved goods.
- •The Rafah crossing is also open for the movement of no some wounded and sick people from Gaza to Egypt, and aid workers into and out of Gaza.
