

OVERVIEW

The snapshot provides a comprehensive overview of the ongoing humanitarian crisis in Gaza as of October 25, 2023, including casualties, particularly among women and children.

Significant damage has been inflicted upon critical infrastructure and essential services,impacting the population's ability to maintain their dignity and basic living standards.

This snapshot highlights reported figures on the impact of hostilities on people in Gaza, where a major humanitarian crisis has unfolded.



26 Oct **Israelis and foreign nationals have been killed in Israel, according to the Israeli authorities (most killed on 7 October)

DAMAGE*



- At least 45% of Gaza's housing units reportedly destroyed or damaged
- 222 education facilities reportedly damaged
- 11 bakeries reportedly destroyed
- 20 hospitals and 24 ambulances damaged
- 20 WASH facilities damaged
- At least 7 churches and 11 mosques damaged

BASIC SERVICES AND LIVLIHOODS

******* FOOD SECURITY

Stocks sufficient for 12 days, but shops may run out in 5 days

The **only** operative mill cannot transform wheat due to elctrecity outages

5-6 hours average waiting time to receive half of normal bread portion

WATER AND SANITATION

92% less water consumption than pre-hostalities (average)

Most of **65** seawage pumping are not operational

70% leekage in a main water pipeline between Rafah and Khan Younis

1 out of 3 water pipelines from Israel is functioning in Khan Younis (600 cubic metres per hour)

Shut down

over **1/3** of the hospitals and nearly **2/3** of primary health care shut down

At high risk

At least **1,000** kidney failure, **9,000** cancer patients, **130** neonates in incubators

Critical shortages

of drugs, blood products and supplies (Fuel at the hospitals is being severely rationed)

EDUCATION

625K students with no access to education

(A)) TELECOMMUNICATION

83% of fixed line users are disconnected


HUMANITARIAN OPERATION

At least 16 health workers, 38 UNRWA staff and 34 civil defence killed while on duty (76 attack on health care facilities)

MOVEMENT AND ACCESS

Closure of crossings with Egypt and Israel, Prohibition of sea access and restrictions, near Israel's perimeter fence.
