



- Over 60% of Gaza's housing units reportedly destroyed or damaged
- 352 education facilities reportedly damaged
- 11 bakeries reportedly destroyed
- 23 hospitals and 53 health care centres out of service

102 ambulances damaged

- At least 3 churches and 115 mosques damaged

BASIC SERVICES AND LIVELIHOODS

** FOOD SECURITY*

- •44% of households report very severe hunger
- •11% of households report severe hunger
- •31% of households report moderate hunger
- ·Situation in the north believed to be catastrophic

WATER AND SANITATION

- Two pipelines coming from Israel supply about 1,100 cubic metres per hour for the south and Middle area.
- · No Access to clean water in the northern governorates. Fuel shortage impacts: 60 water wells, 2 desalination plants, sewage stations and pumps, wastewater treatment.

3 HEALTH

- · Hospitals are under heavy strikes.
- The number of functioning hospitals has dropped from 36 to 8

At high risk

At least 1,000 kidney failure, >2,000 cancer patients, 130 neonates in incubators

Critical shortages

of drugs, blood products and supplies (Fuel at the hospitals is being severely rationed)



625K (100%) Students access to education

Over 69% of all school buildings have sustained damage.

MOVEMENT AND ACCESS

- •The Kerem Shalom crossing has been open since 17 December for approved goods. All other Israeli crossings are closed.
- ·The Rafah crossing with Egypt is open for approved goods, and for the movement of some wounded and sick people, and aid workers.
- ·Access to the sea and to areas near Israel's perimeter fence is restricted.

INCOMING TRUCKLOADS

500 trucks including fuel pre-crisis average per working day in 2023

5,346 trucks excluding fuel with humanitarian aid entered Gaza since 21 October.
