

MOVEMENT AND ACCESS

Between 1-26 April, 42 humanitarian aid missions to northern Gaza were facilitated by the Israeli authorities, 25 were denied or impeded, and 8 were cancelled due to logistical constraints. Moreover, **138** aid missions to areas in southern Gaza that require coordination were facilitated by the Israeli authorities, 20 were denied or impeded, and 12 were cancelled.

•54% (5,263 out of 9,817) of patients who submitted requests for medical evacuation have been approved, of whom 82% (4,325) have been medically evacuated abroad (source: WHO)
