









PALESTINIAN CASUALTIES BY WEAPON 1 JANUARY 2024 - 30 SEPTEMBER 2025





PALESTINIAN CASUALTIES BY GOVERNORATE 1 JANUARY 2024 - 30 SEPTEMBER 2025






- This report reflects information available as of the time of publication. The most updated data and more breakdowns are available at ochaopt.org/data.
- In Israel, 14 Israelis were killed by Palestrinians from the West Bank in attacks that also resulted in the killing of 6 Palestrinians (January 2024 September 2025) and a Palestrinian was killed in an attack by Israelis in West Jerusalem in May 2025. These are counted separately, as this report covers incidents that took place in the West Bank
- 2. In issae, in stream relative that is a transfer and the properties are counted as a reasonal management of the perpetuator. So in the West Bank have been documented by OCHA since 2005, settler violence since 2006, and demolitions and displacement since 2009.

 4. Palestinians or Israelis whose immediate cause of death or the perpetrator's identity remain disputed, unclear, or unknown, are counted separately, so are casualties as a result of "friendly fire" and Palestinian prisoners from the West Bank who have died in Israeli custody. Figures also do not include UXOs, mishandling of weapons, hit-and-run incidents, internal Palestinian clashes, and incidents where the perpetrator's nationality is disputed.







***** Since January 2025, UNRWA has monitored the displacement of Palestine refugee from refugee camps in the northern West Bank through frontline staff and existing hotlines, initially estimating that about 40,000 Palestine refugees have been displaced from Jenin, Tulkarm and Nur Shams refugee camps and their immediate surroundings. In late March 2025, UNRWA launched an SMS-based self-registration survey for formalize and streamline data collection, allowing refugees to report household details, displacement locations, vulnerabilities and basic needs, which was cross-checked through a verification process that was carried out in stages between April and 10 September 2025. As of 10 September, UNRWA-verified displacement figures, based on self-registration of displaced families, indicates that at least 31,919 Palestine refugees have been displaced from the three refugee camps. Verification of the number of displaced people is ongoing and will be updated by UNRWA if new information becomes available.
