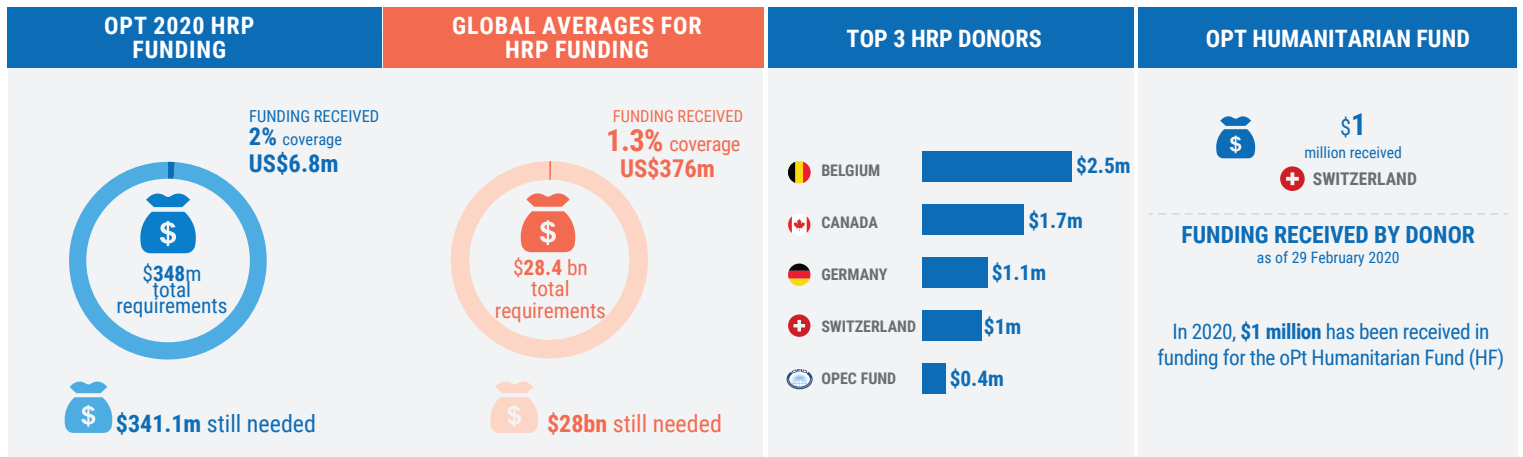


OVERVIEW

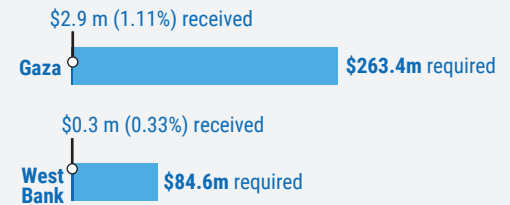

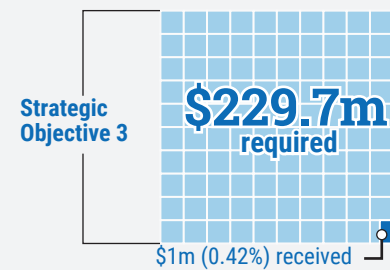

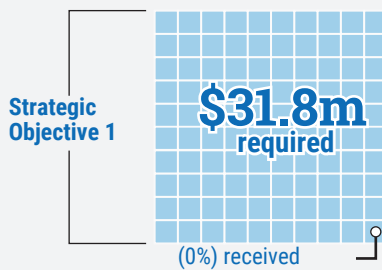

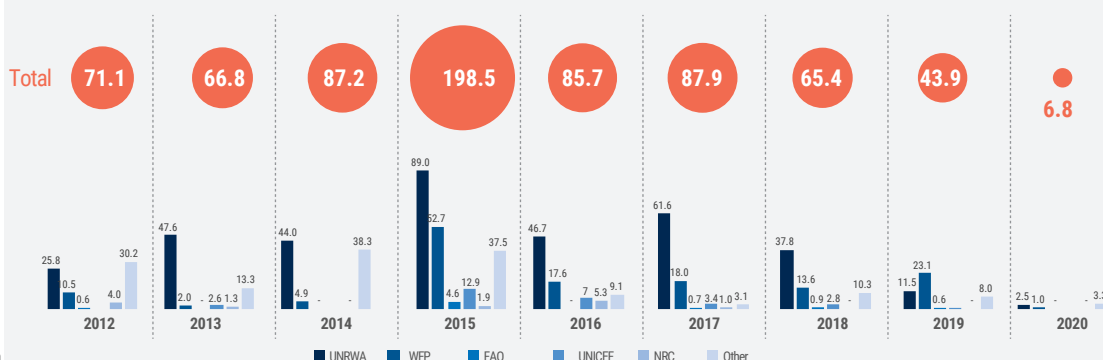

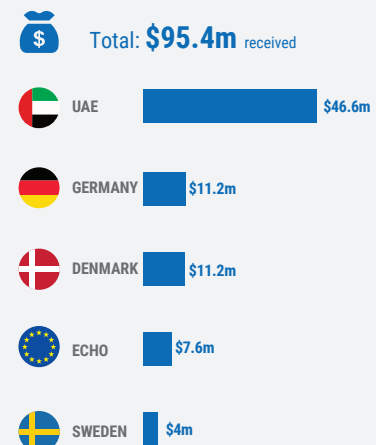

As of February humanitarian funding is 84% lower compared to the same period in 2019 and significantly lower compared to the same period over the last eight years. WFP and UNRWA have received some funding from donors in support of their HRP projects, but this still is significantly lower than previous years. Among NGO's, remarkable funding was provided to Handicap International/Humanity & Inclusion towards their multi-sectorial project targeted out-of-school children with disabilities.

- Activities that address critical gaps in the system or context, which result in widespread need.
