

Closed and Restricted Areas

- Israeli military base: Access is prohibited
- Israeli closed military area: Access is prohibited
- Existing and projected 'closed areas' behind the Barrier: Access is limited to permit holders
- Tunnel/Underpass*: Not counted in the total closure figures.
- Observation Tower*: Not counted in the total closure figures.

Palestinian Communities

- Governorate Capital: Main road, Other road
- Governorate Boundary: Built-up, < 1000 Residents, 1000 - 10,000, > 10,000
- Intended Nature Reserve: Planned Re-routing, Barrier Gate

West Bank Barrier

- Constructed: Red line
- Under Construction: Dotted red line
- Planned Route: Dashed green line

Oslo Interim Agreements (1995-1999)

- Extensive delegation of powers to the Palestinian Authority
- Partial delegation of powers to the Palestinian Authority; joint Israeli-Palestinian security coordination
- Hebron Agreement
- Very limited delegation of powers to the Palestinian Authority
