### Situation Overview

On 7 July 2014 a humanitarian emergency was declared in the Gaza Strip, following a severe escalation in hostilities involving intense Israeli aerial and navy bombardment and Palestinian rocket firing.

The targeting and destruction of residential properties in Gaza has been the main cause of civilian casualties, raising concerns regarding respect for the principle of distinction.

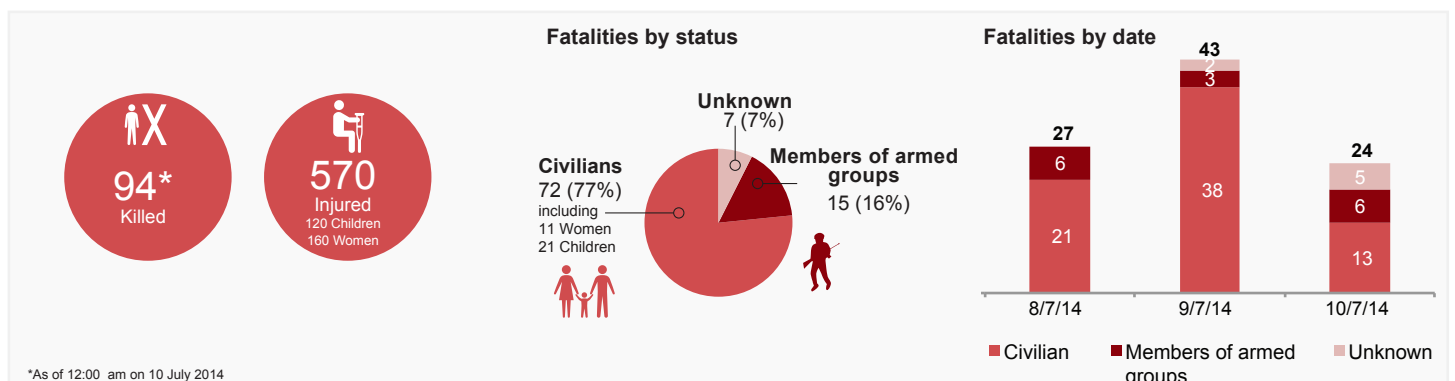

### Known needs, response and funding to date

	Needs	Response
<b>Protection</b>	Children require psychosocial support.	UNICEF and Child Protection Cluster are mobilizing resources.
<b>Shelter and NFI</b>	342 families (2,050 people) need non-food items. Cash assistance is needed to cover rental fees. There is a major shortfall of plastic sheets.	The cluster has a stock for 70,000 people.
<b>Health</b>	Gaza requires US\$ 3.2 million monthly cost for drugs and disposables (72% lack of essential drugs and 46% lack of disposables).	WHO appealed for US\$ 80 million for the MoH. UNRWA appealed for 0.4 million to replenish its medical stock
<b>WASH</b>	US\$1.5 million is the cost of damages in WASH cluster. 70,000 people in need of water.	Half of needed water was provided from alternative sources. UNRWA will provide fuel for critical WASH facilities.
<b>Food</b>	Displaced people with their hosting families in need for food assistance.	1,000 people assisted with food. ACF is planning to provide 100 food parcels.

#### Funding

- US\$ 22 million urgently needed by UNRWA to continue its operations in Gaza and to cover underfunded projects.
- ERF 2 million worth of proposal are being processed to meet critical needs under the SRP.

### oPt Funding by sector (in million US\$)

Of the SRP total request of \$390 million, \$221 million (57%) is for projects targeting the Gaza Strip specifically. Of this \$221 million, less than 30% has been received to date. A further \$68 million is requested for projects targeting the Gaza Strip and the West Bank jointly.
