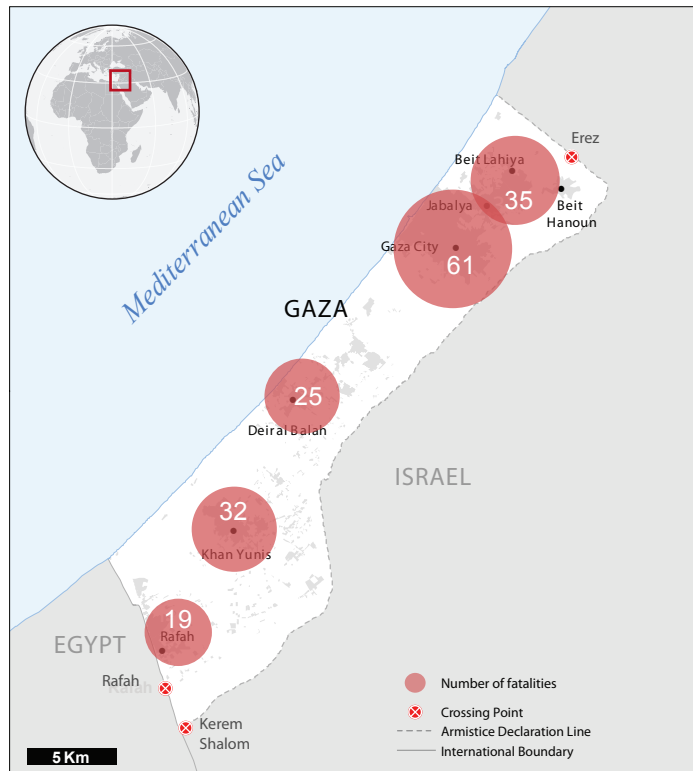


# Occupied Palestinian Territory: Gaza emergency

### Situation Overview

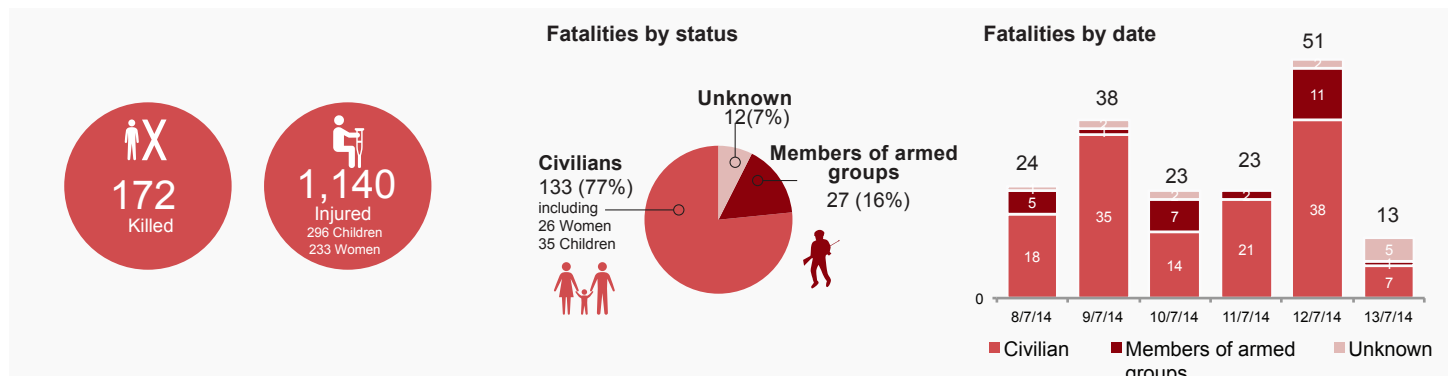
Leaflets were dropped on northern Gaza by the Israeli air force warning residents to evacuate by noon 13 July, ahead of anticipated attacks on rocket launchers in the area. About 16,000 took shelter at UNRWA schools.

Overnight, an Israeli airstrike targeted a house east of Gaza city, killing 18 persons including six children and three women, one of them pregnant.

### Needs, response and funding

	Needs	Response
<b>Protection</b>	25,300 children require specialised support services; Approx. 100 unexploded bombs have been reported.	psychosocial teams have reached 191 children
<b>Shelter and NFI</b>	8,500 people whose homes sustained significant damage & 48,000 people whose homes sustained minor damage need NFI. Cash assistance (US\$ 4.7 m) to cover rental fees and urgent expenses, is needed.	Emergency shelter kits for 750 families, and cash assistance worth (US\$ 3.7 m) are available for distribution.
<b>Health</b>	60 US\$ million to cover medical supplies and referral of patients to treatment out of Gaza	Medical supplies worth US\$ 800,000 & six truckloads (inc. 2,500 boxes) of humanitarian assistance, were donated to the MoH and PRCS.
<b>WASH</b>	Water supply to more than 31,000 people cut or disrupted in Beit Hanoun, Gaza city, and Khan Yunis. Serious concern of contamination in Al Montar water reservoir.	28,013 litres of diesel were distributed by UNRWA; The Beit Hanoun Municipality repaired the three damaged main water pipelines in Beit Hanoun; supply to around 300 families was restored.
<b>Food</b>	Up to 60,000 people expected to be hosted in UNRWA shelters & over 215 displaced families hosted by relatives, are in need of emergency food assistance.	Over 1 million receive food aid (regular caseload)
<b>Funding</b>	22 million USD urgently needed by UNRWA to continue its operations in Gaza and to cover underfunded projects	2 US\$ million worth of proposals are being processed by ERF/OCHA to meet underfunded projects in the SRP

### oPt Funding by sector (in million US\$)

Of the SRP total request of \$390 million, \$221 million (57%) is for projects targeting the Gaza Strip specifically. Of this \$221 million, less than 30% has been received to date. A further \$68 million is requested for projects targeting the Gaza Strip and the West Bank jointly.
