

During April 2022, the occupied Palestinian territory Humanitarian Fund (oPt HF) supported 21 ongoing projects with a total of US\$ 8.2 million, addressing urgent needs in the Gaza Strip (66 per cent) and the West Bank (34 per cent). Projects focused on education, food security, health, protection, emergency shelter and NFI, and WASH. Of these, 11 projects are being implemented by International NGOs, seven projects by national NGOs and three projects by UN agencies. Of the 14 projects implemented by INGOs and the UN, six are implemented in partnership with national NGOs.



*An additional \$1.1 M are pledged from Switzerland while \$1.5 are in the pipeline from Ireland and Norway.


