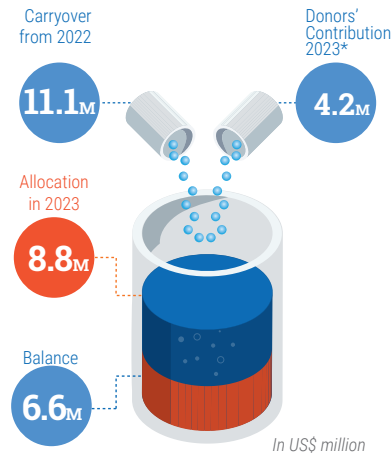


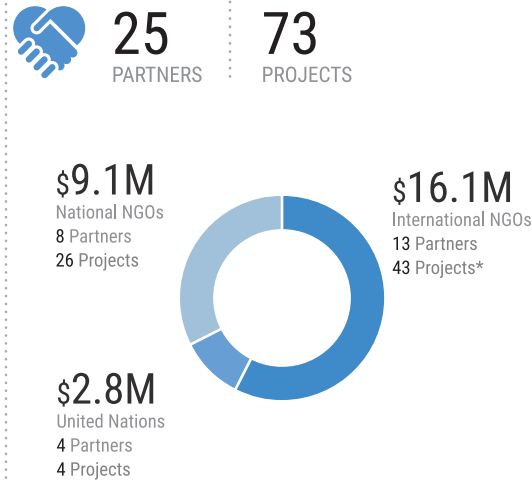
During April 2023, the occupied Palestinian territory Humanitarian Fund (oPt HF) had a total of 73 ongoing projects, for a total of US\$ 28 million, addressing urgent needs in the Gaza Strip (55 per cent) and West Bank (45 per cent). Projects focus on the areas of Education, Food Security, Health, Protection, Emergency Shelter & NFI, WASH, Coordination and Support Services, and Multi-Purpose Cash Assistance. Of these, 43 projects are being implemented by international NGOs, 26 projects by national NGOs and four projects by UN agencies. Of the 47 projects implemented by INGOs or the UN, 31 are being implemented in partnership with NNGOs.

TOTAL FUNDING, ALLOCATION AND BALANCE



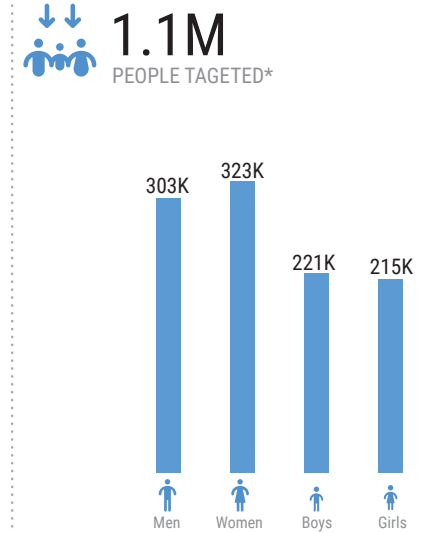

ONGOING PROJECTS BY PARTNER TYPE



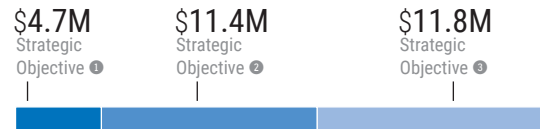

ONGOING PROJECTS BY STRATEGIC FOCUS

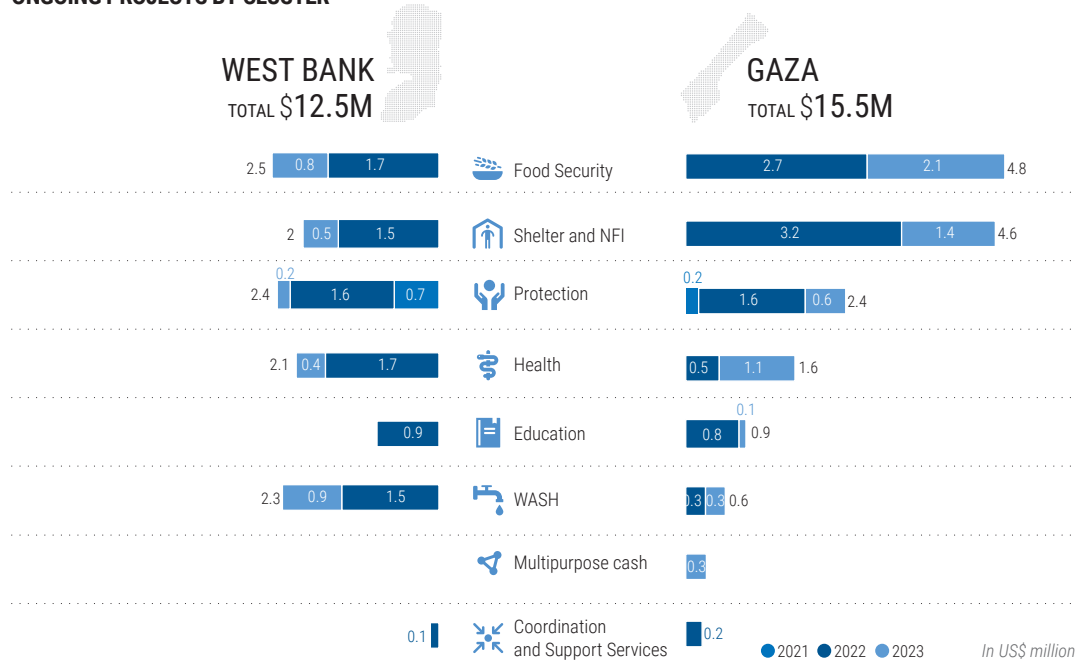

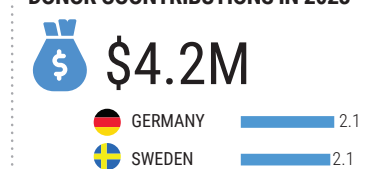
Strategic Objective 2: The basic needs of vulnerable Palestinians living under occupation are met through the provision of quality basic services and improved access to resources.
