During December 2023, the occupied Palestinian territory Humanitarian Fund (oPt HF) had a total of 85 ongoing projects, for a total of US\$ 35.3 million, addressing urgent needs in the Gaza Strip (61 per cent) and West Bank (39 per cent). Projects focus on the areas of Education, Food Security, Health, Protection, Emergency Shelter & NFI, WASH, Coordination and Support Services and Multi-Purpose Cash Assistance. Of these, 52 projects are being implemented by international NGOs, 29 projects by national NGOs and four projects by UN agencies. Of the 56 projects implemented by INGOs or the UN, 33 are being implemented in partnership with NNGOs.

The oPt HF is currently prioritizing and finalizing its critical and time-sensitive First Reserve Allocation, amounting to US\$40 million with projects in line with the 2023 Flash Appeal. It represents the first phase of planned responses tailored to the evolving situation. Projects approved under this allocation will appear in coming monthly updates respectively.


