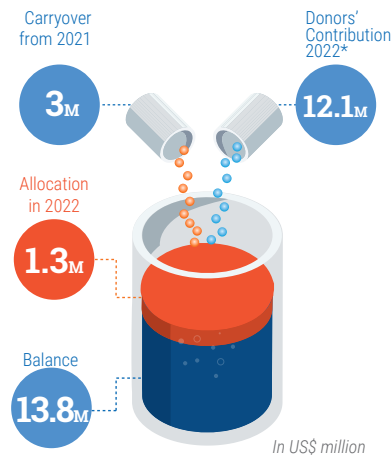


During July 2022, the occupied Palestinian territory Humanitarian Fund (oPt HF) had a total of 24 ongoing projects, for a total of US\$ 7.6 million, addressing urgent needs in the Gaza Strip (46 per cent) and West Bank (54 per cent). Projects focus on the areas of Education, Food Security, Health, Protection, Emergency Shelter & NFI, and WASH. Of these, 14 projects are being implemented by international NGOs, nine projects by national NGOs and one project by a UN agency. Of the 15 projects implemented by INGOs or the UN, seven are being implemented in partnership with NNGOs.

Currently, around \$10 million are under consideration as part of the the first Standard Allocation of the year.

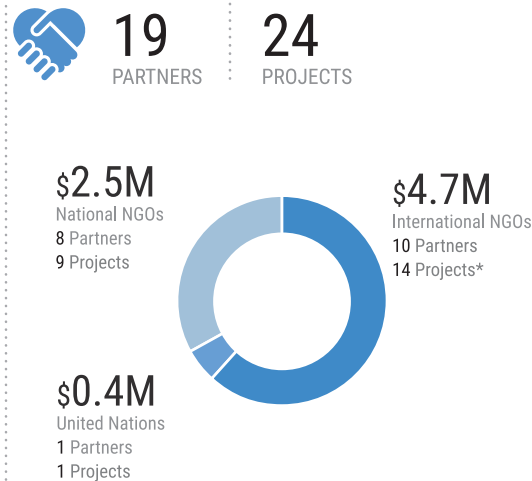
TOTAL FUNDING, ALLOCATION AND BALANCE



*An additional \$5M are in the pipeline from Germany and Spain.

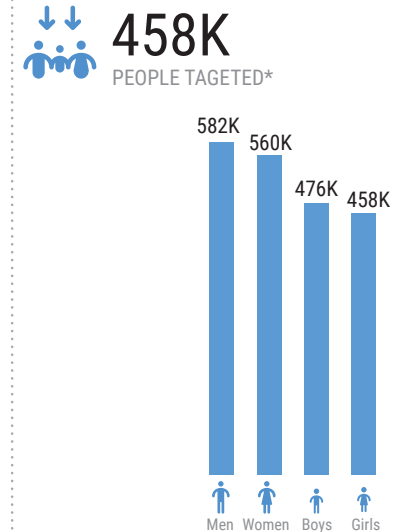
** The \$12.1 million includes \$0.5 million from Italy, committed in 2021 but paid in 2022.

ONGOING PROJECTS BY PARTNER TYPE



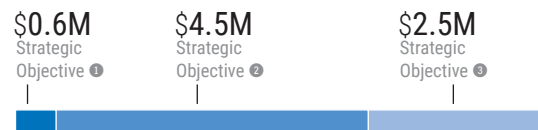
*Seven INGO projects (\$0.7M) are implemented in partnership with NNGOs.

ONGOING PROJECTS BY STRATEGIC FOCUS

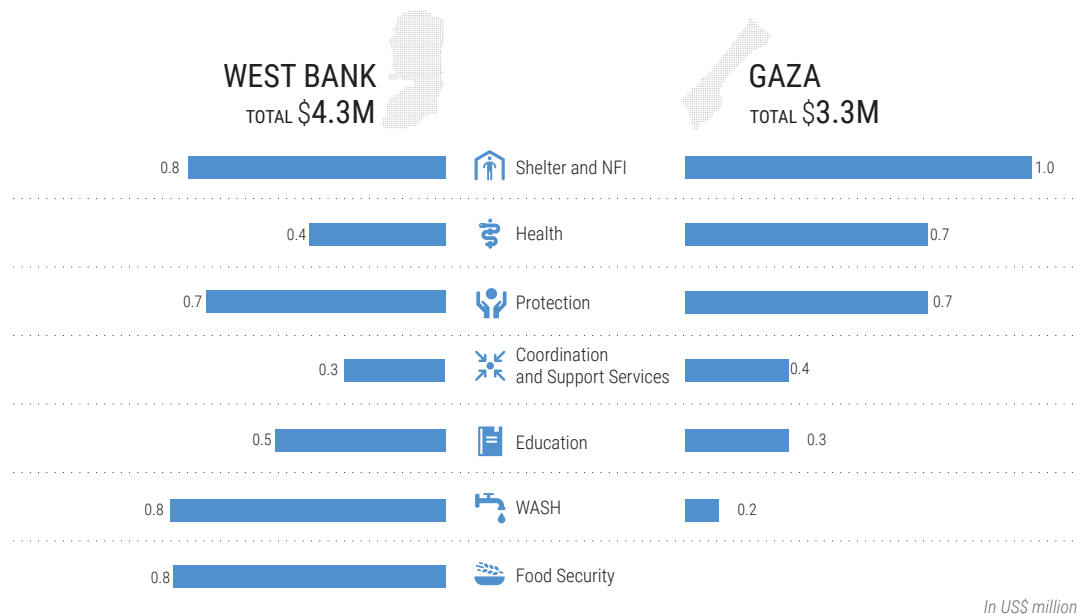

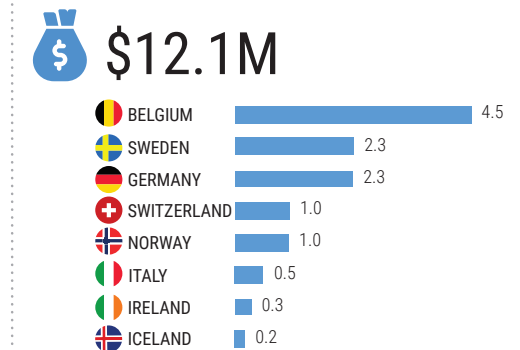
Strategic Objective ②: The basic needs of vulnerable Palestinians living under occupation are met through the provision of quality basic services and improved access to resources.
