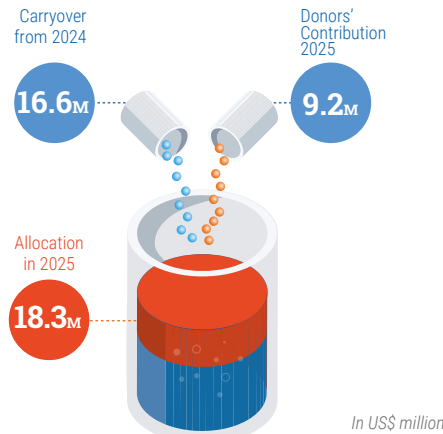


During March 2025, the occupied Palestinian territory Humanitarian Fund (oPt HF) managed a total of 110 ongoing projects, totaling US\$67.6 million. These projects aimed to address urgent needs in the Gaza Strip (89 per cent) and the West Bank (11 per cent). The projects were strategically focused on Education, Food Security, Health, Protection, Emergency Shelter & Non-Food Items (NFI), Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH), Coordination and Support Services, Multi-Purpose Cash Assistance and Nutrition, and Camp Coordination & Camp Management.

Of these projects, 56 projects are being implemented by international non-governmental organizations (INGOs), 42 by national NGOs and 12 by UN agencies. Notably, 43 out of the 68 projects implemented by INGOs or the UN are being implemented in collaboration with national NGOs.

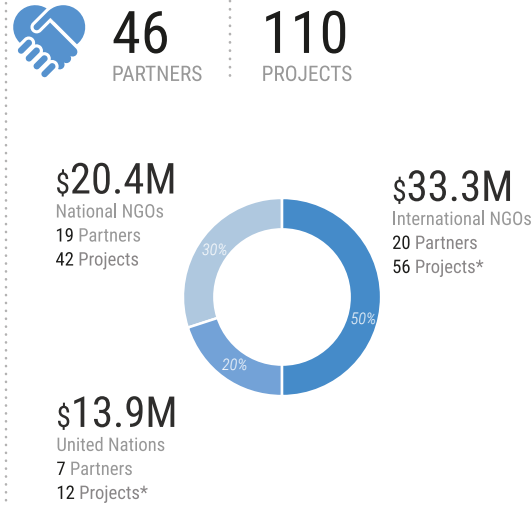
The oPt HF is currently finalizing its critical and time-sensitive Reserve Allocation of \$30 million to address urgent needs in Gaza. This allocation aligns with the priorities outlined in the oPt Flash Appeal 2025, enabling a rapid scale-up of humanitarian responses to the most vulnerable Palestinians. It will provide lifesaving support for displaced populations and returnees, adapting to population movements—including relocations and returns—to ensure context-specific and evidence-based aid in high-need areas. Funding will be directed toward essential needs and services, including shelter, water, sanitation, health, and protection, while also expanding the use of cash-based assistance for rapid response. Projects approved under this allocation will be included in upcoming monthly updates.

TOTAL FUNDING AND ALLOCATION BALANCE

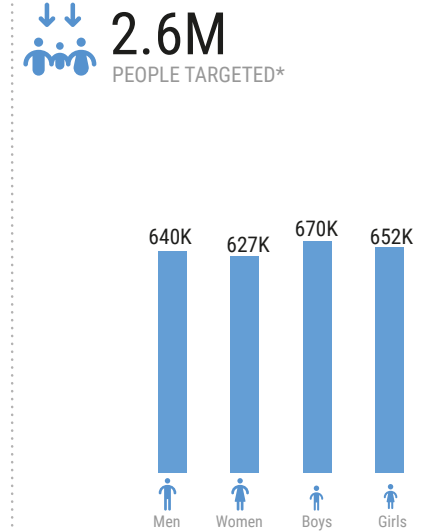

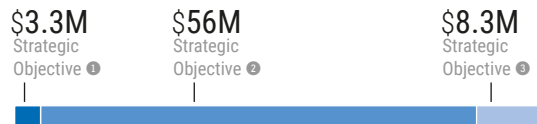
ONGOING PROJECTS BY PARTNER TYPE

ONGOING PROJECTS BY STRATEGIC FOCUS

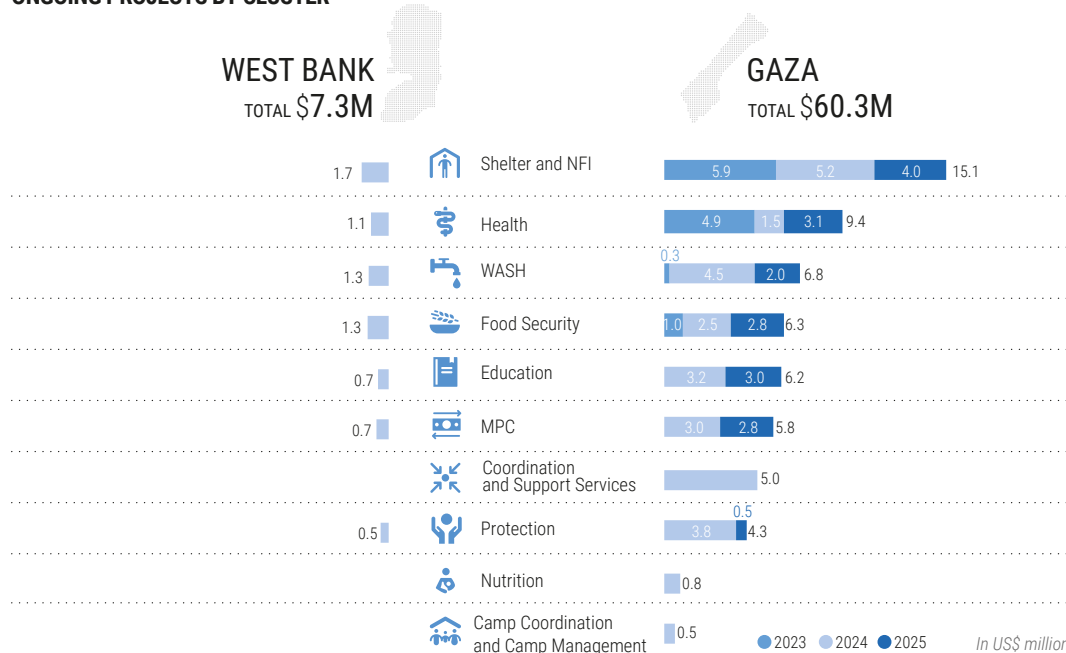

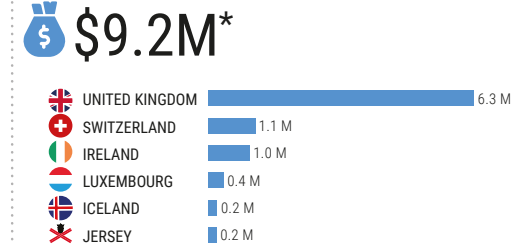
Strategic Objective 2: The basic needs of vulnerable Palestinians living under occupation are met through the provision of quality basic services and improved access to resources.
