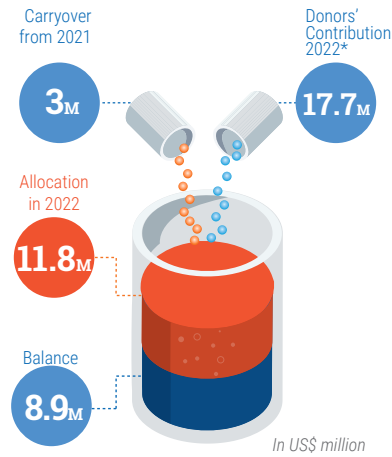


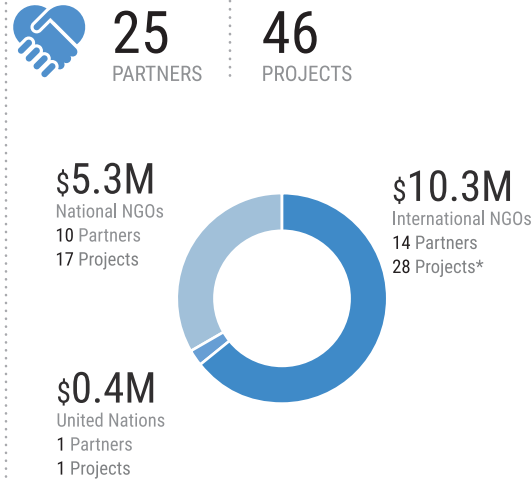
During November 2022, the occupied Palestinian territory Humanitarian Fund (oPt HF) had a total of 46 ongoing projects, for a total of US\$ 16 million, addressing urgent needs in the Gaza Strip (54 per cent) and West Bank (46 per cent). Projects focus on the areas of Education, Food Security, Health, Protection, Emergency Shelter & NFI, WASH and Coordination and Support Services. Of these, 28 projects are being implemented by international NGOs, 17 projects by national NGOs and one project by a UN agency. Of the 29 projects implemented by INGOs or the UN, 18 are being implemented in partnership with NNGOs.

TOTAL FUNDING, ALLOCATION AND BALANCE



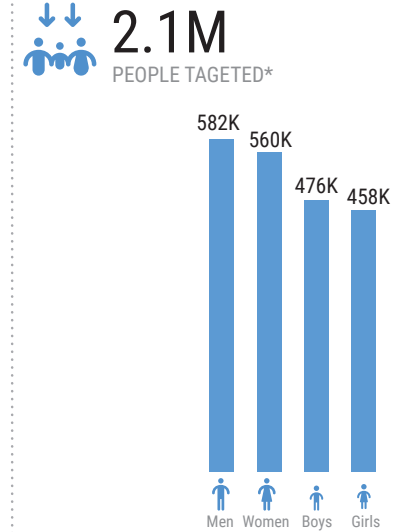

ONGOING PROJECTS BY PARTNER TYPE



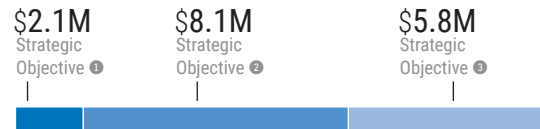
*18 INGO projects are implemented in partnership with NNGOs (\$1.8M indirectly)

ONGOING PROJECTS BY STRATEGIC FOCUS

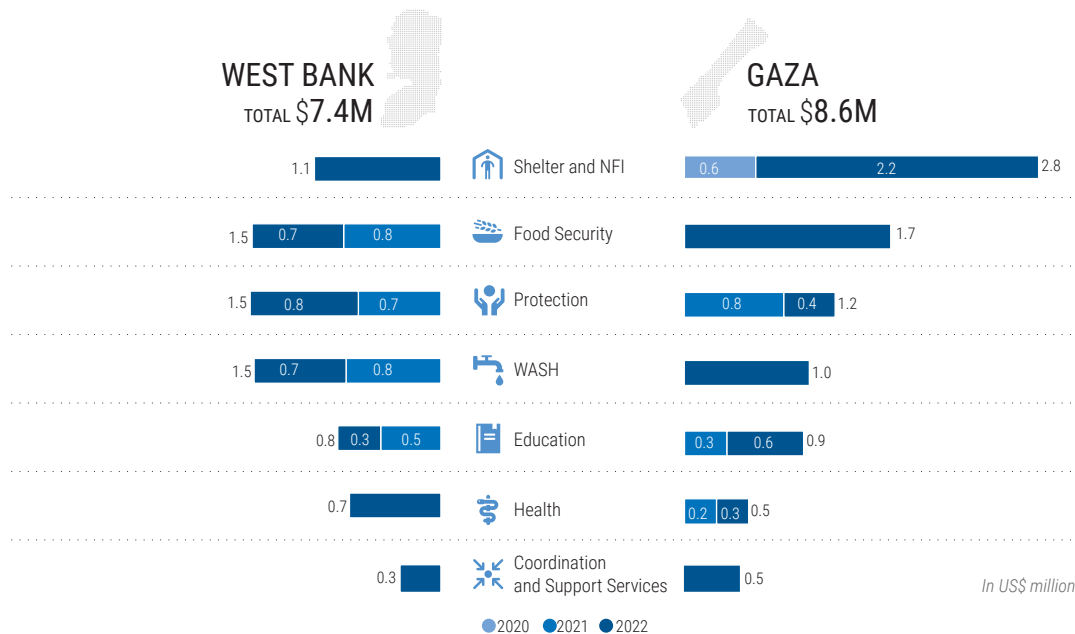

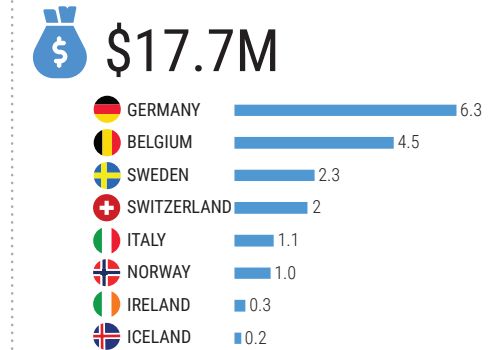
Strategic Objective 2: The basic needs of vulnerable Palestinians living under occupation are met through the provision of quality basic services and improved access to resources.
