


During November 2023, the occupied Palestinian territory Humanitarian Fund (oPt HF) had a total of 79 ongoing projects. for a total of US\$ 33.2 million, addressing urgent needs in the Gaza Strip (64 per cent) and West Bank (36 per cent). Projects focus on the areas of Education, Food Security, Health, Protection, Emergency Shelter & NFI, WASH, Coordination and Support Services and Multi-Purpose Cash Assistance. Of these, 48 projects are being implemented by international NGOs, 27 projects by national NGOs and four projects by UN agencies. Of the 52 projects implemented by INGOs or the UN, 31 are being implemented in partnership with NNGOs.

Within the unfolding emergency and the ongoing war, the oPt Humanitarian immediately launched a 48-hour Allocation of US\$9 million, that aims to address the most pressing humanitarian needs of Palestinians in Gaza. Due to the ongoing war, funding is being channeled through implementing partners that are able to immediately respond to the immense humanitarian needs on the ground. An additional US\$4.1 million are being processed as part of the 2nd Standard Allocation 2023 to address West Bank needs.

*An additional \$40.1 million are in the form of pledges or pipeline payments, where \$30.6 M are pledged from the United Kingdom (\$4.9 M), Sweden (\$1.4 M), Switzerland (\$22.1 M) and in private contibutions (\$2.2M), while a total of \$9.5 M are in the pipeline from Spain (\$0.9 M), Germany (\$3.2 M), Belgium (\$2.1 M), Ireland (\$1.5 M) and Norway (\$1.8 M)



ONGOING PROJECTS BY STRATEGIC FOCUS



Strategic Objective 2: The basic needs of vulnerable Palestinians living under occupation are met through the provision of quality basic services and improved access to resources.


Strategic Objective 3: The capacity of vulnerable Palestinians to cope with and overcome protracted crisis, including from environmental threats, is supported.
