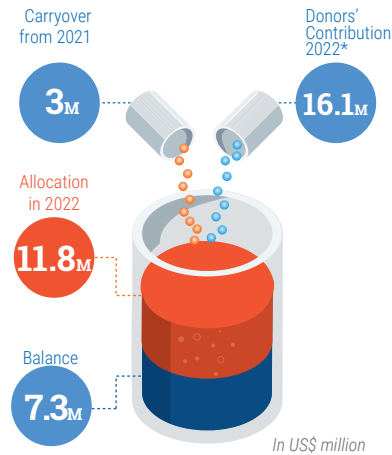


During September 2022, the occupied Palestinian territory Humanitarian Fund (oPt HF) had a total of 51 ongoing projects, for a total of US\$ 17.4 million, addressing urgent needs in the Gaza Strip (53 per cent) and West Bank (47 per cent). Projects focus on the areas of Education, Food Security, Health, Protection, Emergency Shelter & NFI, WASH and Coordination and Support Services. Of these, 30 projects are being implemented by international NGOs, 20 projects by national NGOs and one project by a UN agency. Of the 31 projects implemented by INGOs or the UN, 19 are being implemented in partnership with NNGOs. Currently, majority of the first Standard Allocation 2022 projects have been processed and are ongoing (\$10.6 million).

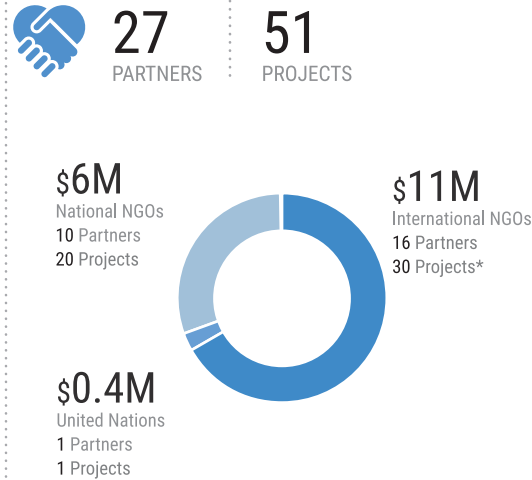
TOTAL FUNDING, ALLOCATION AND BALANCE



*An additional \$1.3M are in the pipeline from Italy and Spain while \$1.1M is pledged from Switzerland.

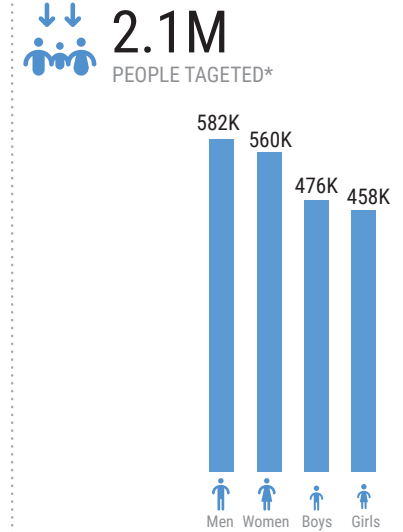
** The \$16.1 million includes \$0.5 million from Italy, committed in 2021 but paid in 2022.

ONGOING PROJECTS BY PARTNER TYPE



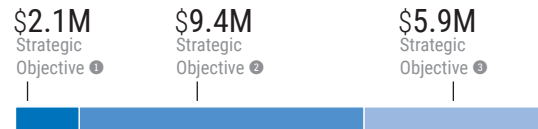
*19 INGO projects are implemented in partnership with NNGOs (\$1.8M indirectly)

ONGOING PROJECTS BY STRATEGIC FOCUS

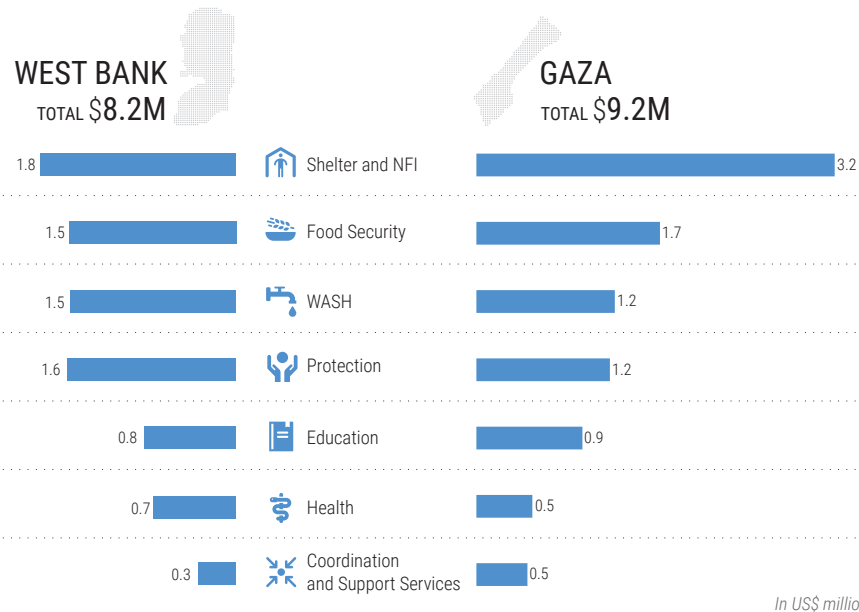

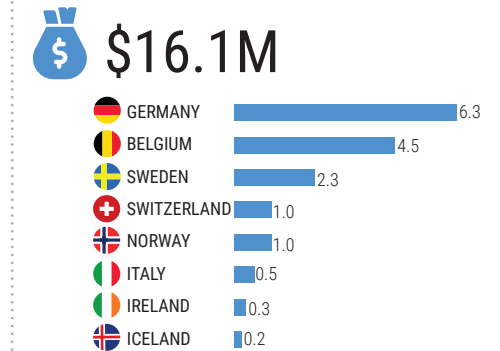
Strategic Objective ②: The basic needs of vulnerable Palestinians living under occupation are met through the provision of quality basic services and improved access to resources.
